

CCXP25 Presents "Road to Hell": A Celebration of 20 Years of Supernatural with Misha Collins, Kathryn Newton, Jim Beaver, Rob Benedict, and Richard Speight Jr.

Cast members will attend the event from December 4–7, 2025, at São Paulo Expo



São Paulo, April 7, 2025 – *Supernatural* turns 20 in 2025, and CCXP25 — the world's biggest pop culture festival — will host a celebration worthy of one of the most beloved genre series of the past two decades. Called "Road to Hell", the special event will bring together cast members Misha Collins, Kathryn Newton, Jim Beaver, Rob Benedict, and Richard Speight Jr. for the largest *Supernatural* celebration in the world, taking place from December 4 to 7 at São Paulo Expo. Kathryn Newton will be attending on December 4, 5, and 6.

As part of the anniversary, *Road to Hell* offers fans a chance to connect with the stars through a variety of experiences, including individual photo ops, selfies, autographs, and more surprises to be announced soon. A special bundle will also be available, giving fans access to all these experiences in one package.

All five guests will also join fans on the Thunder and Omelete stages for panels on



Thursday (Dec 4) and Friday (Dec 5), where they'll share behind-the-scenes stories, interact with the audience, and celebrate 20 years of *Supernatural*. A full schedule will be released soon by the event organizers.

Meet the confirmed guests:

Misha Collins won over audiences worldwide as the angel Castiel, becoming one of the emotional cornerstones of *Supernatural*. His role grew in prominence throughout the seasons, cementing Collins as a fan favorite. Off-screen, he's also a writer and activist. He recently portrayed Harvey Dent in the CW series *Gotham Knights* and has appeared in *24*, *ER*, and *NCIS*. Collins is the founder of Random Acts, a nonprofit that promotes global kindness initiatives.

Kathryn Newton first appeared as Claire Novak in *Supernatural*, a role that introduced her to the show's massive fanbase. She went on to build a successful career in both film and television, with highlights including *Big Little Lies, Pokémon: Detective Pikachu*, and the teen horror-comedy *Freaky*. In 2023, she joined the Marvel Cinematic Universe as Cassie Lang in *Ant-Man and the Wasp: Quantumania*.

Jim Beaver, best known as the gruff but lovable hunter Bobby Singer, is a veteran of American television. His extensive résumé includes memorable roles in *Deadwood*, *Justified*, *Breaking Bad*, and *The Boys*. Also a screenwriter and historian, Beaver remains a fan favorite for his layered performance in *Supernatural*.

Rob Benedict portrayed Chuck Shurley — who was eventually revealed to be God in one of the show's most surprising twists. In addition to acting, Rob is the frontman of the band Louden Swain, a favorite among fans thanks to their performances at *Supernatural* conventions. With his charisma and sense of humor, Rob is a beloved figure in the fan community.

Richard Speight Jr., the unforgettable Archangel Gabriel — also known as the Trickster — is a cherished name among fans. Beyond his on-screen role, he also worked behind the camera, directing several acclaimed episodes of the series. Known for his wit and strong connection with the fandom, Richard is a familiar presence at fan events around the world.

The presence of the *Supernatural* cast at CCXP25 is a tribute to the series' enduring legacy. Across 15 seasons, the show built a passionate global fanbase and became a cornerstone of genre television. *Road to Hell* is a chance to relive iconic moments, hear untold stories from the cast, and connect with the actors who brought this universe to life.
